

As of January 1, 2020 Recreational Cannabis use is Legal in the State of Illinois



An Illinois resident who is 21 years of age or older can have in their possession:



500 Milligrams Of THC (edibles)

30 Grams Of Raw Cannabis (1 Ounce)

5 Grams Of Cannabis Concentrate (1 tsp)

5 Cannabis Plants (only Medical Cannabis Card Holders)



Property owners may allow any cannabis smoking, growing, and cultivating of any marijuana on their property

They can also prohibit it if they choose

These issues should be addressed within the lease

Violations of the lease agreement (smoking cannabis in a rental) are not police enforceable.



Frequently Asked Questions



Q: Can cannabis plants be grown in public view

A:

Cannabis plants must be grown in an enclosed locked space not within the view of the public. Cannabis plants may only be grown by residents with a Medical Cannabis Card. Cannabis grows are NOT permitted for recreational users.



Q: Can cannabis be consumed in public

A:

Cannabis cannot be consumed in any public place or knowingly in close physical proximity to anyone under 21 years of age.

Cannabis cannot be consumed in any public place where a person could reasonably be expected to be observed by others



Q: What is a public place?

A:

A "public place" is defined as any place where a person could reasonably be expected to be observed by others.

A "public place" includes all parts of buildings owned in whole or in part, or leased, by the state or a unit of local government.
